Support, train, and mentor next generation of NTD researchers.



Leverage TMRC expertise, field sites, existing specimens, and collected data to conduct pilot studies.




Scope of research limited to NTD that is being studied at collaborating TMRC for each submission.



Opportunity Fund Management

Examples of research this program would consider:

Retrospective study using already captured data for publication.

Studies of a cohort nested within a parent study.

Characterizing pathogens from existing specimens.

Purchasing supplies to conduct additional analyses on existing specimens.

Supporting study results dissemination and manuscript publication.



Examples of research NOT considered:

Human subjects research requiring new IRB approval

Clinical trials

Animal study requiring new IACUC approval

Topics not within TMRC Network scope

Conduct/ attendance of workshops or trainings

Salary supplement

Research within US Life Sciences DURC Policy or HHS P3CO Framework



Eligibility

- International and U.S. researchers who are in the early stage of their careers
- Submissions will be completed by the primary TMRC
 - Named investigator should be an existing collaborator on the TMRC's currently funded project
 - Each center may submit <u>multiple</u> applications but ultimately it is anticipated that only one application per TMRC at most will be funded
 - Limited to two performance sites



TMRC Engagement

TMRCs are expected to work closely with selected applicants on their application.


- Provide support on grantsmanship, biostatistics, and other application needs.
- Application process is considered part of the capacity-building.

Each applicant must include a <u>Letter of Collaboration</u> from the affiliated TMRC.

Funding



• For Co-PIs across TMRCs, each TMRCs would each receive a subaward, with the total funding for the combined award not exceeding \$20,000.

Award Process

Award Notification: July 14, 2023

- Notified by TMRC CC via email
- Applicants required to respond with their acceptance and intent to conduct proposed work

First Quarterly/Kick-Off Meeting

Subaward Negotiations

- U.S. government approvals and Foreign Clearance (~1-3 months)
- Regulatory approval and documentation (no later than 2 months after award notice)

Public Award Announcement

Awarded studies will be featured on TMRC Network website and network-wide email



Post-Award Activities



Invoicing

Payment schedules will be defined during subaward negotiations.



Data Sharing

Awardees and the TMRC CC will establish infrastructure for data sharing.



Reporting

One interim progress report (6-month) and a final report (12-month) will be required.



Scientific Publications

Awardees are required to cite collaborating TMRC and TMRC CC awards in resulting products.
