Support, train, and mentor next generation of NTD researchers.



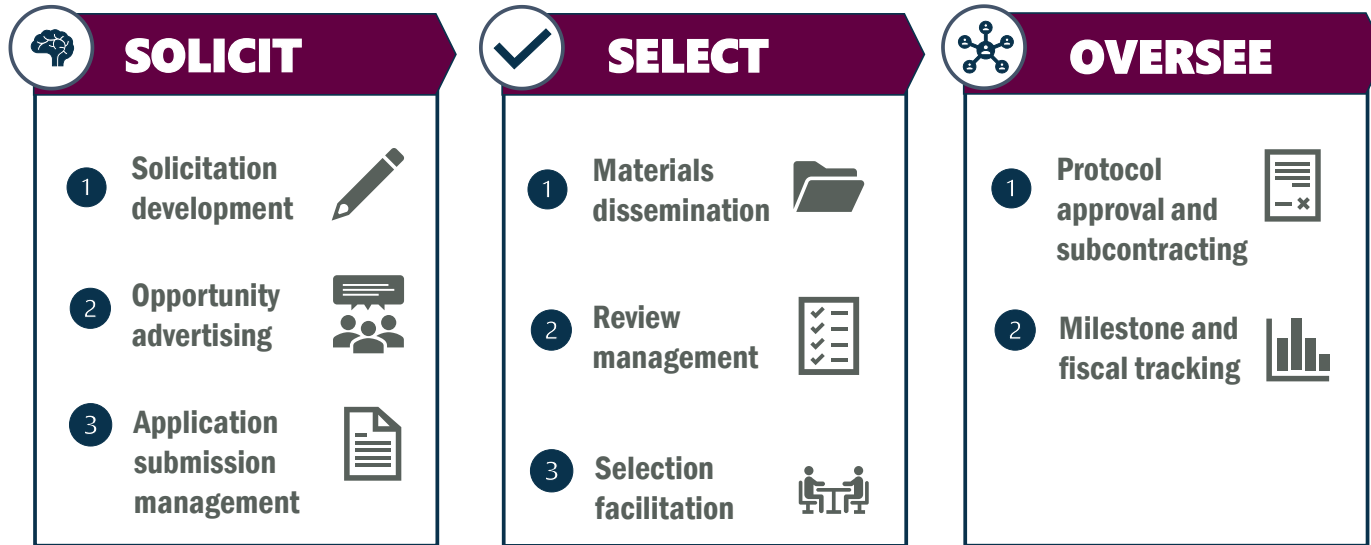
Leverage TMRC expertise, field sites, existing specimens, and collected data to conduct pilot studies.



Scope of research limited to NTD that is being studied at collaborating TMRC for each submission.

Opportunity Fund Management

Eligibility

- International and U.S. researchers who are in the early stage of their careers
- Submissions will be completed by the primary TMRC
 - Named investigator should be an existing collaborator on the TMRC's currently funded project
 - Each center may submit one application
 - Limited to two performance sites
- 2023 awardees are not eligible for 2024 funds

TMRC Engagement





TMRCs are expected to work closely with selected applicants on their application.

- Provide support on grantsmanship, biostatistics, and other application needs.
- Application process is considered part of the capacity-building.

Each applicant must include a Letter of Collaboration from the affiliated TMRC.

- See submission guidelines (page 10) for letter requirements.

- Recommendations from NIAID and the SAG may be included and must be addressed for subcontracts to be executed.

Award Process

Award Notification: November 18, 2024

- Notified by TMRC CC via email
- Applicants required to respond with their acceptance and intent to conduct proposed work
- There may be recommendations from NIAID and/or the SAG that must be addressed in the protocol before the subaward process can begin.

Kick-Off Meeting


- Review SAG/NIAID feedback
- Next steps and responsible parties


Subaward Negotiations


- U.S. government approvals and Foreign Clearance (~3 months)
- Regulatory approval and documentation (1-2 months after award notice)


Post-Award Activities



-  **Invoicing**

Payment schedules will be defined during subaward negotiations.
-  **Data Sharing**

Awardees and the TMRC CC will establish infrastructure for data sharing.
-  **Reporting**

One interim progress report (6-month) and a final report (12-month) will be required.
-  **Scientific Publications**

Awardees are required to cite collaborating TMRC and TMRC CC awards in resulting products.
